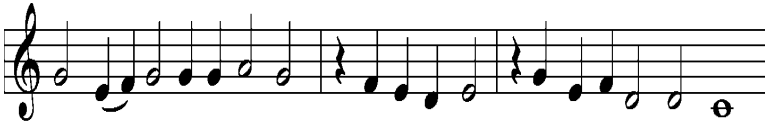

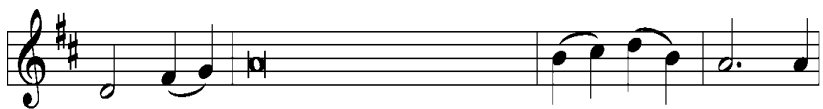

## **NEW FURNACES NEEDED FOR THE SANCTUARY**

An upgrade is needed to the 2 furnaces that supply heat to the sanctuary. The congregation voted to replace them at a cost of \$7,100.00. There was also a discussion of a fundraiser within the congregation to raise the needed monies for the project. The goal is to prevent the depletion of the current Building Fund. We ask that special gifts to the Building Fund for the furnaces be placed in the collection plates or mail them to the church with funds earmarked for the Building Fund – Furnaces.

The purpose is to keep our social distancing and time to sanitize and get the church ready for each service.
